## RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS & INDEMNIFICATION

In exchange for the right to hunt on the property of the Geneva Lake Conservancy, Inc. (hereafter referred to as Land Owner), located in the Town of \_\_\_\_\_, Wisconsin, the Participant agrees to the following:

Participant waives for his or her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs, any and all rights and claims for damages, losses, demands and any other actions whatsoever, which he or she, individually or in solido, may have or which may arise against Land Owner, and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents, including but not limited to any and all injuries, damages or illnesses suffered by Participant and/or Participant's property, which may, in any way whatsoever, arise out of, be related to or be connected with hunting or in any way connected with his or her presence on the property of Land Owner. Participant on behalf of himself or herself and his or her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs, hereby expressly release Land Owner and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents from any and all such claims.

Participant hereby expressly assumes the risk of entering the land of Land Owner and of taking part in activities relating to hunting on the land of Land Owner which include, but are not limited to, the discharge of firearms and the firing of live ammunition and use of and presence on the land of Land Owner.

Participant agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend Land Owner and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents from any and all fault, liabilities, costs, expenses, claims, demands or lawsuits arising out of, related to or connected with the discharge of firearms, use of and presence on land of the Land Owner. And should any such claim, demand or lawsuit arise or be asserted in any way whatsoever related thereto, whether arising under the laws of the United States, any state, or under any theory of law or equity, Participant will indemnify, hold harmless and defend Land Owner and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents, from any and all costs, expenses or liability including, but not limited to, the cost of any settlement or judgment made or rendered against Land Owner and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents, whether individually, jointly, or in solido with Participant, together with all costs of court and other costs or expenses incurred in connection with any such claim, demand or lawsuit, including attorney's fees.

Participant furthermore hereby acknowledges and agrees that he or she has read, understands and will at all times abide by this agreement.

This instrument binds Participant and his or her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs.

## **Geneva Lake Conservancy Hunting and Trapping Regulations**

- I. No hunting and trapping shall be allowed without a permit to hunt or trap on Geneva Lake Conservancy's Public Preserves.
- II. Permits are on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- III. Hunting and Trapping Permits may be obtained online by visiting [www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org](http://www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org) and filling out the on-line application. If you are unable to apply online, you can call the Geneva Lake Conservancy office at 262-275-5700. Applicants must furnish their identification (including a valid driver's license) and WDNR hunting or trapping license.
- IV. There will be no fee for the permit.
- V. There will be a maximum of 2 permits issued per day at the Hansen preserve during all open hunting and trapping seasons.
- VI. Permits must be carried at all times when hunting or trapping on GLC preserves and shall be displayed if requested

### **HUNTING REGULATIONS**

1. Hunters are to assume that hikers will be on the trails, fisherman and boaters will be on Sugar Creek, regardless of posting.
2. Hunters may not hunt within 100 feet of a building devoted to human occupancy.
3. A map of the preserve will be attached to the permit. It is the hunter's responsibility to ensure that he/she does not trespass on private property.
4. Baiting for any reason is prohibited.
5. Tree stands/blinds may be used but cannot be left up overnight. No nails, screws, or any devices that could damage trees are allowed. The cutting of tree limbs is prohibited.
6. The cutting of trails to hunting stands is prohibited.
7. ATVs and other motorized vehicles are prohibited unless for hunters with disabilities as authorized by a GLC representative.
8. Target shooting is prohibited.
9. Permitted hunters are requested to report any non-permitted hunters or illegal and restricted activities at the GLC preserve to the Walworth County Sheriff's Office.
10. Hunters are not allowed at the park earlier than one hour before sunrise or later than one hour after sunset.
11. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the preserves.
12. Camping and fires are not allowed.
13. Hunting shall be limited to shotgun, muzzle loader, pistol, bow and arrow or crossbow.

### **TRAPPING REGULATIONS**

1. The permit is only valid for the dates listed on the permit.
2. Trappers are to assume that hikers will be on the trails and boaters and fisherman will be on and along Sugar Creek and other waterways. See above
3. A map of the Park area will be attached to the permit. It is the trapper's responsibility to ensure that he/she does not trespass on private property. See above

4. The cutting of trails to traps is prohibited.
5. ATVs and other motorized vehicles are prohibited unless for trappers with disabilities as authorized by a GLC representative.
6. Permitted trappers are requested to report any non-permitted trappers or illegal and restricted activities at GLC preserves to the Walworth County Sheriff's Office. See above
7. Trappers are not allowed in the Park earlier than one hour before sunrise or later than one hour after sunset.
8. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
9. Camping and fires are not allowed.
