## **GENEVA LAKE CONSERVANCY HUNTING AND TRAPPING UPDATES FOR HANSEN PRESERVE 10/29/18**

**NO PERMITS REQUIRED EXCEPT FOR DEER GUN HUNTING** --Effective immediately, it will no longer be necessary to obtain a permit for bow deer hunting, trapping and all other hunting except for the nine-day deer gun hunting season. Please note that two permits per day on the Hansen Preserve will be issued for the nine-day gun hunting season. **GUN HUNTING PERMITS FOR THE HANSEN PRESERVE HAS ALREADY BEEN FILLED FOR THE 2018 GUN DEER HUNTING SEASON.** (Permits for the 2019 Gun Deer Hunting Season will be issued beginning January 1, 2019 on a first-come, first serve basis) Gun hunters who have not registered and received a permit from the Geneva Lake Conservancy will not be allowed to hunt on the Hansen preserve during these nine days.

Hunters also will **NOT** be required to carry a hard copy of the Conservancy's permit with them at all times. Instead, hunters must have a state hunting license and be able to have the status of their license verified electronically.

**NO TRAPPING PERMITS REQUIRED** --Effectively immediately, it will no longer be necessary to obtain a permit for trapping. Trappers will be expected to follow state regulations. Upland trappers are required to check traps daily and required to have their DNR customer number (license number) on their traps; water traps must be checked every four days, minimum.

## **GENEVA LAKE CONSERVANCY HUNTING AND TRAPPING RULES Updated 10/29/2018**

1. All hunters and trappers on Geneva Lake Conservancy's public preserves are asked to register or, for the nine-day gun hunting deer season, obtain a permit.
2. Permits are on a first-come, first serve basis.
3. Gun Deer Hunting Permits may be obtained online by visiting [www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org](http://www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org) and filling out the on-line application. If you are unable to apply on-line, you can call the Geneva Lake Conservancy office at 262-275-5700. Permit applicants must furnish their driver's license number and WDNR hunting customer ID 2number (if known).
4. There will be no fee for the permit.
5. There will be a maximum of two permits issued per day at the Hansen preserve during the gun deer season.

## **HANSEN PRESERVE RULES**

1. The preserve is open to hiking, canoeing, kayaking, hunting, fishing, cross country skiing and wildlife viewing. Visitors are asked to respect other users.
2. Users are asked to respect private property boundaries. A map of the preserve is available at [www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org](http://www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org). – Hansen Preserve.
3. Baiting for any reason is prohibited.
4. Tree stands/blinds may be used but cannot be left up overnight. No nails, screws, or any devices that could damage trees are allowed. The cutting of tree limbs is prohibited.
5. The cutting of trails to hunting stands is prohibited.

6. No dumping or littering is allowed.
7. ATVs and other motorized vehicles are prohibited unless for hunters with disabilities as authorized by a GLC representative.
8. Target shooting is prohibited.
9. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the preserves.
10. Camping and fires are not allowed.
