RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS & INDEMNIFICATION

In exchange for the right to hunt on the property of the Geneva Lake Conservancy, Inc. (hereafter referred to as Land Owner), located in the Town of _____, Wisconsin, the Participant agrees to the following:

Participant waives for his or her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs, any and all rights and claims for damages, losses, demands and any other actions whatsoever, which he or she, individually or in solido, may have or which may arise against Land Owner, and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents, including but not limited to any and all injuries, damages or illnesses suffered by Participant and/or Participant's property, which may, in any way whatsoever, arise out of, be related to or be connected with hunting or in any way connected with his or her presence on the property of Land Owner. Participant on behalf of himself or herself and his or her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs, hereby expressly release Land Owner and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents from any and all such claims.

Participant hereby expressly assumes the risk of entering the land of Land Owner and of taking part in activities relating to hunting on the land of Land Owner which include, but are not limited to, the discharge of firearms and the firing of live ammunition and use of and presence on the land of Land Owner.

Participant agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend Land Owner and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents from any and all fault, liabilities, costs, expenses, claims, demands or lawsuits arising out of, related to or connected with the discharge of firearms, use of and presence on land of the Land Owner. And should any such claim, demand or lawsuit arise or be asserted in any way whatsoever related thereto, whether arising under the laws of the United States, any state, or under any theory of law or equity, Participant will indemnify, hold harmless and defend Land Owner and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents, from any and all costs, expenses or liability including, but not limited to, the cost of any settlement or judgment made or rendered against Land Owner and any of his or her heirs, employees, directors, officers or agents, whether individually, jointly, or in solido with Participant, together with all costs of court and other costs or expenses incurred in connection with any such claim, demand or lawsuit, including attorney's fees.

Participant furthermore hereby acknowledges and agrees that he or she has read, understands and will at all times abide by this agreement.

This instrument binds Participant and his or her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs.

Hansen Preserve

RULES OF GENERAL USE

1. This preserve is open to hiking, hunting, fishing, cross country skiing and wildlife viewing. Visitors are asked to respect other users.
2. Users are asked to respect private property boundaries. A map of the preserve is available at www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org.
3. No dumping or littering allowed.
4. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the preserve.
5. Camping and fires are not allowed.

HUNTING & TRAPPING RULES (Updated 10/29/19)

- NO PERMITS REQUIRED EXCEPT FOR DEER GUN HUNTING. It is no longer necessary to obtain a permit for bow deer hunting, trapping and all other hunting EXCEPT FOR THE NINE-DAY DEER GUN HUNTING SEASON. However, all hunters and trappers on Geneva Lake Conservancy's public preserves are asked to register with Geneva Lake Conservancy online at www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org or by calling the GLC office at 262-275-5700.
- A maximum of two permits per day on Hansen Preserve will be issued for the nine-day gun hunting season beginning January 1 on a first-come, first serve basis. There is no fee for the permit.
- Gun Deer Hunting Permits may be obtained online by visiting www.GenevaLakeConservancy.org and filling out the on-line application or by calling the Geneva Lake Conservancy office at 262-275-5700. Permit applicants must furnish their driver's license number and WDNR hunting customer ID number (if known).
- Gun hunters who have not registered and received a permit from the Geneva Lake Conservancy will not be allowed to hunt in Hansen Preserve during these nine days.
- Hunters are NOT required to carry a hard copy of the Conservancy's permit with them at all times but must have a state hunting license and be able to verify the status of the license electronically.
- Trappers will be expected to follow state regulations. Upland trappers are required to check traps daily and have a DNR customer number (license number) on their traps; water traps must be checked every four days, minimum.
- Tree stands/blinds may be used but cannot be left up overnight. No nails, screws, or any devices that could damage trees are allowed. The cutting of tree limbs is prohibited.
- The cutting of trails to hunting stands is prohibited.
- ATV's and other motorized vehicles are prohibited unless for hunters with disabilities as authorized by a GLC representative.
- Target shooting is prohibited.
- Baiting for any reason is prohibited.

Hunting types include shotgun, rifle, muzzle loader, pistol, bow and arrow, or crossbow. Deer, Bear, Small Game, Fall Turkey and Wolf shooting hours listed from 30 minutes before sunrise to 20 minutes after sunset for Zone A in the Southern Area are listed on the DNR website: <https://dnr.wi.gov/topic/hunt/regulations.html> (Under Shooting Hours, Southern Area).
