### **Description of Activities**

#### **Helen Rohner Children's Fishing Park Maintenance and Education Duties**

- Perform daily maintenance chores at park: water plants, weed gardens, organize materials at Nature Center, and other duties as assigned.
- Organize and lead nature classes for children at least once weekly and assist in those organized by Barrett Memorial Library, Geneva Lake Fishing Club and other organizations.
- Encourage families in their use of the park and assist in instructing children on nature in the park, particularly in Southwick Creek and the amphibian pond.
- Develop and implement ideas to encourage GLC memberships from park attendees.
- Help organize special activities at the park and events associated with the new amphibian pond and boardwalk.
- Organize and implement a "small nature" photography contest at the park and build engagement in the contest through some microscopes and other promotions.
- Work with the Community Outreach director to organize annual Fourth of July events and an August event to coincide with the Lion's Club corn roast.
- Encourage people to use nature-based educational materials available at the nature center.
- Assist the Land Protection Specialist in organizing and conducting volunteer work days and in implementing land restoration activities, including cutting and removing invasive species, planting native plants, etc.
- Assist the Executive Director in various activities as assigned.

The internship pays \$400 a week for 10 weeks beginning in May or June. The intern will be reimbursed for gas mileage and other expenses related to the job.
