Phosphorus / Chloride Reduction

 _Water softener set to regenerate on usage, rather than automatic
 _Minimal use of road salt on driveway
 _Written instruction to lawn care company not to use phosphorus-based fertilizer or blow or dump

Does not water lawn for one week after fertilizing and tests soil to determine if fertilizer is needed at all.
Dark Skies / Light Pollution
Are all outside lights directed to only where needed? (ie. facing the ground, not the sky)
Are all outside lights only used when needed/ are they on a timer or motion-activated?
Do all the outside lights have a clear purpose? (ie. to light a walkway)
