There will be three age groups: (4-12) (13-21) (22+). Each age group will have a First (\$150), Second (\$100), and Third (\$50) prize winner. The deadline to submit is Sunday, August 15th.

According to Mikayla Kucia, summer intern at the Conservancy, the Fishing Park is a great place to learn about the importance of small nature. "All summer long, we have been teaching children through our nature classes," Kucia stated. "What most interests everyone – kids and parents alike – are the tiny insects, the bumble bees, the butterfly larvae... the things that remind us that nature is all around us, no matter how small."
